### PROM

**PLACE:** Ashton Place

**DATE:** Saturday, May 13, 2017

**TIME:** Prom Check-In will begin at 6:30pm.  
Dinner will begin promptly at 7:30pm.  
Students will not be allowed in to Prom after 8:00pm.  
Students will not be allowed to leave until 10:00pm.  
Prom concludes at 10:30pm.  
**Please plan transportation accordingly.**

### POST PROM

**PLACE:** Six Flags Great America  
Busses will depart from Ashton Place and Glenbard East. **Please plan transportation accordingly.**

**DATE:** May 13-14, 2017

**TIME:** May 13, 10:30pm – May 14, 5:30am  
Busses will begin boarding at 10:00 p.m. at Ashton Place and Glenbard East  
Busses will depart from Ashton Place and Glenbard East at 10:30pm  
Six Flags Great America Event 11:45 p.m. – 4:00 a.m.  
Busses depart Great America for Ashton Place and Glenbard East at 4:00 a.m.  
Busses arrive at Ashton Place and Glenbard East at approximately 5:30 a.m.

### TICKET INFORMATION

**Prom Cost/Purchase Dates:** April 25<sup>th</sup>-April 27<sup>th</sup> \$130 for a couple/\$65 for an individual ticket  
Tickets can be purchased in all lunch periods outside of the cafeteria

April 28<sup>th</sup> \$150 for a couple/\$75 for an individual ticket  
Tickets can be purchased before or after school in the Guidance Office. **Tickets are non-transferable and non-refundable**

**Post Prom Cost:** Tier 1: Early Bird Tickets, March 22<sup>nd</sup> – March 24<sup>th</sup> \$30 per ticket  
Tier 2: Early Bird Tickets, April 7<sup>th</sup>, April 13<sup>th</sup>, April 21<sup>st</sup> \$35 per ticket  
Tier 3: April 25<sup>th</sup>-April 27<sup>th</sup> \$40 per ticket

**Tickets are non-transferable and non-refundable**

**Ticket price includes: Transportation (Charter Bus), a buffet dinner, and entry into Six Flags Great America.**

**Ticket Requirements:**

- GEHS students must present a photo ID when purchasing Prom/Post Prom tickets (people who do not attend GEHS will not be allowed to purchase tickets).
- If a GEHS student invites a date that does not attend the school, **a paper copy of the photo ID and Prom/Post Prom Guest Form from the non-GEHS student are REQUIRED at the time of ticket purchase. These forms can be found in the Dean's Office.**
- **In addition, students attending post prom must complete a post prom permission form**
- Students are not allowed to have dates younger than freshman year and not older than 20 years of age.
- Freshman and sophomore students are allowed to attend the event only if accompanied by a junior or senior student.

**Prom Dinner:** A buffet style cuisine with a Chicago Taste

**Prom Court:** All juniors and seniors will be sent a survey through their FirstClass email account. Students will be allowed to vote for the Prom King and Queen from the top 5 male nominations and top 5 female nominations at Prom. Prom King and Queen will be announced at Prom.

**Prom and Post Prom are school-sponsored events,** which means all rules apply to all students and guests. If you are suspended the week prior to prom, you will not be allowed to attend. Glenbard East does not endorse any limousine services and we are asking that students are cautious when making reservations with any company.

**Additional Information**

- There will be a dress code at Prom. Students may attend Post Prom in either their Prom attire, or dressed more casually in school appropriate attire. Of course both Prom and Post Prom will be smoke-free and alcohol-free events, regardless of age.
- Although Glenbard East junior and senior students do not need to attend prom to participate in post prom, the post prom event is not open to guests unless the guest was in attendance at Prom.
- **Students attending prom are required to be in attendance at school on Friday, May 12<sup>th</sup>.**
