4. EXAM MAKE-UP – Students who have an excused absence from an exam may make arrangements with their teacher to make up the exam during the Day 3 make-up session. Students may also arrange with teachers to make up exams during Resource Periods.
5. TECHNOLOGY CENTER OF DUPAGE – The last day of student attendance for TCD will be Thursday, May 25, 2017.
6. QUIET STUDY AREAS – Supervised quiet study areas will be available for those students who wish to study during the exams, when they have a free period. All Physical Education and Driver Education classes **WILL MEET ON EXAM DAYS**. There are to be no students in the halls without a pass during the exam periods. All students are to remain in their classes during the entire period.
7. RESCHEDULED EXAMS – Students who feel they have a heavy load of exams on Day 1 or Day 2, may elect to change or move one of their exams during the Rescheduled/Makeup time slot on Day 3. Students who wish to reschedule an exam must do so one week before the final.
8. SCHOOL CODE – School Code requires that Districts schedule a minimum of 300-minutes of instruction and student support during the last day of each academic semester. Passing periods do not count toward the 300-minute requirement.
9. GRADUATING SENIORS – Thursday, May 25, 2017 will be the final day for graduating seniors to attend class. Friday, May 26, 2017 will be the last day of senior attendance. All final exams for graduating seniors should take place prior to Friday, May 26, 2017.
