- 1. <u>CAFETERIA SERVICE</u> There will be limited food service on exam days. The Cafeteria lines will be open to serve our students during the following times: 7:30 a.m.-8:00 a.m. for breakfast.
- 2. <u>EXAM MAKE-UP</u> Students who have an excused absence from an exam may make arrangements with their teacher to make up the exam during the Exam Make-up Sessions. Students may also arrange with teachers to make up exams during Resource Periods.
- 3. <u>TECHNOLOGY CENTER OF DUPAGE</u> There will be no TCD classes for students on exam days.
- 4. <u>QUIET STUDY AREAS</u> Supervised quiet study areas will be available for those students who wish to study during the exams, when they have a free period. All Physical Education and Driver Education classes WILL MEET ON EXAM DAYS. There are to be no students in the halls without a pass during the exam periods. All students are to remain in their classes during the entire period.
- 5. <u>RESCHEDULED EXAMS</u> Students who feel they have a heavy load of exams on Day 1 or Day 2 may elect to change or move one of their exams to the Make-up time slot on Day 3. This request must be made with the teacher at least one week prior to their scheduled exam.
- 6. <u>SCHOOL CODE</u> School Code requires that Districts schedule a minimum of 300-minutes of instruction and student support during the last day of each academic semester. Passing periods do not count toward the 300-minute requirement.
- 7. <u>ATHLETICS</u> Practices may begin after 2:00 p.m. Students should check with their coach for actual start time.
